The fitted kitchen has been fully renovated, with quarry tile flooring, and has an antique pine table seating six, so there is a choice of eating here or in the dining room. It has a built-in fridge, dishwasher, electric hob, electric oven with a grill and a microwave.

The large utility room has a separate entrance leading directly into the garden. There is a washing machine, dryer, freezer, laundry sink, shoe rack, ironing facilities and an overhead drying rack.

The cloakroom has a washbasin and toilet.



First Floor

The master bedroom has a king-size bed and ensuite shower room a large shower and toilet.

There are two further bedrooms with twin beds, which can be linked to form super king-size beds, if required.



All the bedrooms are carpeted, with ample wardrobe and drawer space. Linen and towels are provided. A travel cot is available (without bedding), as well as stairgates and a high chair.

The fully tiled family bathroom has a bath, a separate large shower, toilet and washbasin.



Rosedean Cottage Clearwell Forest of Dean



Rosedean Cottage is a beautifully presented three bedroom detached home, which accommodates up to six people, plus a cot. The cottage was completely renovated by the owner in late 2006 to an immaculately high standard and has received a 4-star rating from VisitBritain.

There is ample off-road parking and a secure garden for children with a barbeque and garden furniture. The lockable garage can be used to store bikes. The cottage has oil fired central heating and constant hot water. All utilities are included.

Rosedean is located in Clearwell, one of the prettiest villages in the Forest of Dean. Clearwell, named in the 13th century, means "the spring amongst the clovers" and is found in the Wye Valley Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. About two miles away flows the river through the famous Symonds Yat and past Tintern Abbey, reaching the Severn estuary at Chepstow.
